ORDER

1. The petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution, complaining of alleged ongoing construction in *Municipal No. 429, Ward No. II, Kucha Brij Nath, Chandni Chowk, Delhi-110006*.
2. At the outset, Mr. Bhojraj, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petition may be disposed of by permitting the petitioner to approach the Special Task Force ["STF"], constituted by the Supreme Court *vide* orders dated 24.04.2018 and 18.07.2018 in W.P.(C) 4677/1985 [*M.C. Mehta vs Union of India & Ors.*].
3. In the event, the complaint is made to the STF within a period of two weeks from the date of this order, the STF is directed to act expeditiously.



4. The petition is disposed of with these directions.
5. It is made clear that these submissions have been recorded without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the owners/occupants of the property, and their rights and remedies are expressly reserved.
