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1. The present petition impugns circular dated 28th October, 2024,¹

CIRCULAR

Subj: Organization of Delhi State School Games (THROWBALL) 2024-25.

In continuation of Circular No. DE-41/Sports/2017/1564-70 dated 10/09/2024, Sports Branch, Directorate of Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi will conduct Delhi State School Games for the year 2024-25 in the discipline of Throwball from 11/11/2024 to 25/11/2024. The Throwball tournament will be conducted in Under-14, Under-17 and Under-19 years (Boys & Girls) age group.

All the zonal SPIs/Convener/Secretaries are hereby directed to send Girls and Boys entries in the prescribed Performa (Annexure-I&II), duly attested by the concerned SPIs/Convener/Secretaries I to S, till 10/11/2024 from 8:00 AM onwards at Govt. Boys Sr. Sec. School, Badli, Delhi - 110042.

The stamp of the Head of the school on the Performa should be clearly visible and legible. The stamp on the photo of the student should have been affixed in such a manner that half of it should be on the photo and half on the Performa.

Age Group (Boys & Girls)	Eligibility
Under 14 years	Should be born on or after 01.01.2011
Under 17 years	Should be born on or after 01.01.2008
Under 19 years	Should be born on or after 01.01.2006

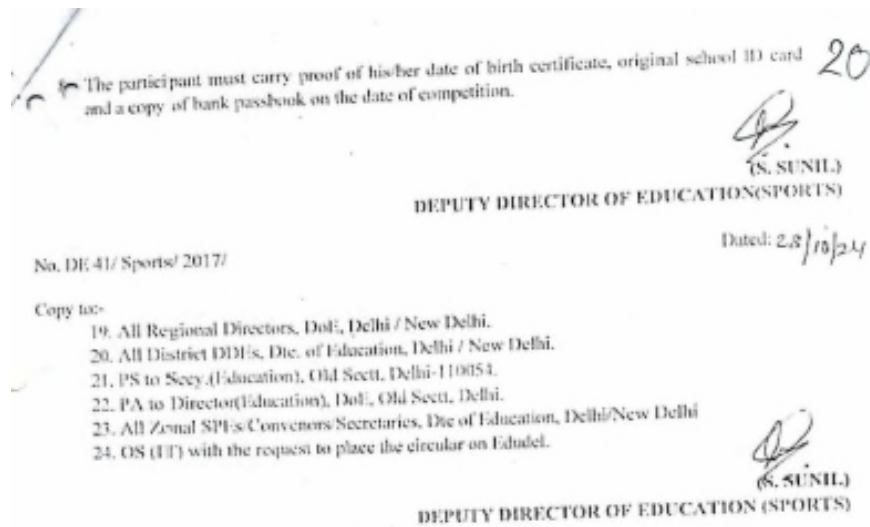
The players will have to report in the proper playing kit. Ms. Deepika Vats (9315029441) will be in-charge of the game.

Instructions for participation:

- The students of Kendriya Vidyalaya and those studying in below class VI are not eligible to participate in the above competition.
- To verify age eligibility, any two of the following documents are required: -
 - Aadhar Card or Passport.
 - Matriculate certificate.
 - Birth certificate issued at least 05 years before the year of tournament i.e. on or before 1st of January 2019 for Delhi State School Games 2024 by Municipal corporation/Gram Panchayat.
- In case of need, a student might have to undergo medical examination for age verification from the Govt. hospital.
- In case of any dispute, protest can be lodged with protest fees of Rs.500/- within one hour of completion of the event. No request would be allowed after the stipulated time.
- Participant must possess a valid Aadhar number.
- Decision of Technical committee would be final.
- A student can participate in only one category in a particular year.

2. In respect of the afore-noted circular, the Petitioner alleges that Respondent No. 1 has appointed Respondent No. 2 as incharge and Organizing Secretary of the upcoming Delhi State School Games (Throw-Ball) 2024-2025 in violation of its rules and regulations despite having full knowledge of the fact that she is not a regular teacher employed by Delhi Administration. It is further alleged that in the past, Respondent No. 1 has consistently appointed regular teachers as incharge and Organizing Secretary of Delhi State Games and in the upcoming Delhi State Games, no exception ought to have been made as far as the appointment of Respondent No. 2 for the game of Throw-Ball is concerned.

3. The Court has noted the facts and contentions urged by the parties. During the course of the submissions, it has been emphasized that appointment of Respondent No. 2 is irregular, however, there are no documents on record to support any of the grounds urged in the petition. On a plain reading of the impugned circular, it can only be gathered that Respondent No. 2 has been made incharge of the game.

4. In absence of any material on record to show the apointment of



Respondent No. 2, the Court finds no merit in the present petition.

5. In light of the above, the present petition along with pending application is dismissed.
