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1. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the present, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the respondents are directed to expeditiously decide the petitioner's representation dated 04.10.2024 made before the Director General, Central Reserve Police Force (in short, "CRPF").
2. Issue notice. Learned counsel for the respondents accepts notice and has no objection to this limited prayer of the petitioner.
3. In view of the stand taken by the parties, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to decide the petitioner's



representation dated 04.10.2024, by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks.

4. Needless to state, in case, the petitioner is aggrieved by the order so passed by the respondents, it will be open for him to seek legal recourse as permissible in law.

5. The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
