ORDER
22.11.2024

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1. Petitioners are seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for wilful disobedience of the directions contained in order dated 27.09.2024 passed by learned coordinate Bench of this Court in W.P.(C) 13646/2024.
2. The above said order records a direction to respondent No.1 to take a final view on the show-cause notice, in light of the response dated 21.08.2024 submitted by the petitioners within a period of four weeks from such order.
3. It is contended that the above said period has already expired and there is no decision/final view on the above said show-cause notice in terms of the specific directions given by learned Coordinate Bench.
4. Learned counsel for the respondent appears on advance notice and submits that though all the related aspects have already been taken



care of while they had issued an order dated 18.09.2024 but, in all fairness, learned counsel for the respondent also admits that subsequent to the above said order dated 27.09.2024, there is no further order.

5. On instructions, it is undertaken by learned counsel for the respondents that the above said directions shall be complied within three weeks from today.

6. Such assurance is taken on record.

7. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that, at the moment, he does not press his present petition but in case the representation is not decided within the above said period of three weeks, he may be given liberty to revive the present petition.

8. The petition is, accordingly, disposed of. Liberty, as prayed, is granted.
