ORDER
19.11.2024

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1. The Petitioner states that they have rendered various services as well as supplied goods to the Respondents as per the work orders issued by them, the details of which have been narrated in the representation-cum-legal notice dated 21st September, 2024. Mr. Abhijat, counsel for Petitioner submits that since no response has been received from the Respondents in terms of the aforementioned representation, the limited prayer sought in the present writ petition is for seeking a direction to the Respondents to take a decision on the aforementioned representation in a time bound manner.
2. On the query of the Court, Mr. Abhijat confirms on instructions that the claims raised in the representation are live and not time barred as on



date. Be that as it may, without going into the merits of the case and reserving all rights and contentions of the parties, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Respondents to take a decision on the Petitioner's representation-cum-legal notice dated 21st September, 2024 by passing a reasoned and speaking order, which shall be intimated to the Petitioner within a period of six weeks from today.

3. With the above directions, the present writ petition is disposed of along with pending application(s).
