ORDER

04.12.2024

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1. The present petition has been filed seeking the grant of interim bail for six weeks on medical ground.
2. The medical report has been called from the Superintendent, Central Jail No. 1, and as submitted, the report dated 03.12.2024 reads as follows: -

SUB: MEDICAL STATUS REPORT IN R/O ACCUSED RAJEEV SINGH @ RAJEEV S/O CHARAN SINGH IN CASE FIR NO. 568/2023 PS- KASHMIRI GATE.

Hon'ble Sir/Madam,

This is in reference to the order dated 29.11.2024 passed by Hon'ble high Court of Delhi, wherein jail Superintendent is directed to file medical status report of the above said accused on 04.12.2024.

In this regard, copy of the medical status report of the aforesaid accused, as submitted by the Medical Officer In-charge, Central Jail Dispensary of this Jail, is enclosed herewith.

It is further submitted that as per the medical report "As per available medical records, latest on 30.11.2024 inmate patient presented in jail dispensary with alleged history of one fainting episode in bathroom in the morning with presenting complaint of palpitation, sweating with chest heaviness, on examination his S.P was found to be higher side and patient was referred towards DDU Hospital for further necessary treatment after providing primary emergency treatment. At DDU Hospital inmate patient was first examined by S.R casualty and based on symptomatology referred for medicine review. Accordingly inmate patient was examined by medicine S.R. on ECG right bundle branch block was present, inmate patient was provided necessary treatment and referred towards G.B Pant Hospital for Cardiology reference."

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3. Learned counsel the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not in good health and he requires urgent treatment.

4. Learned Additional P.P. has opposed the application on the ground that earlier application moved under same ground was dismissed as withdrawn. Learned Additional P.P. also submits that prosecutrix is yet to be examined and tomorrow is the date fixed before the learned Trial Court. Learned Additional P.P. also submits that the Regular Bail Application is also filed before the learned Trial Court and is now fixed for 13.12.2024. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that the petitioner has a prior criminal record and is involved in other cases as well.

5. This Court is of the firm view that prisoner has also the equivalent right to the adequate and effective medical treatment. The medical report indicates that the petitioner's health is poor, and on 30.11.2024, the petitioner experienced a fainting episode in the bathroom in the morning.

6. I consider that without going into the merits of the case and simply on the ground of medical condition of the applicant, the applicant be admitted on interim bail for a period of 4 weeks from the date of his release, subject to furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned learned Trial Court and subject to the verification of address and his mobile number(s), and subject to the following further conditions:

- a) the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, intimidate or tamper with any person acquainted with the facts of the case;



- b) the petitioner shall remain available on the verified address except visiting to the hospital or doctor and shall not leave the GNCT of Delhi;
 - c) the petitioner shall further remain available on the mobile number provided and shall contact the investigation officer everyday at 5 P.M.
 - d) In case of change of residential address and/or mobile number, the petitioner shall intimate the same to the concerned Trial Court concerned by way of an affidavit.
 - e) the petitioner shall surrender on time after expiry of the interim bail before the Jail Superintendent.
7. Accordingly, the present petition along with pending application stands disposed of.
8. A copy of this order be sent to concerned Jail Superintendent for information and necessary compliance.
