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1. Petitioner requires liver transplant and for this purpose, she has made a representation to the Dean, Authorisation Committee under the Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissues Act, 1994 on 09th November, 2024. It is further asserted that prior representation was also made on 08th May, 2024, however, Petitioner does not have a copy of the said representation.
