Respondent No. 2, the father of Petitioner No. 1, is present in person and submits that he had lodged a missing report regarding his daughter, Pooja, aged 21 years.

Respondent No. 2 further states that he has never issued any threats to the petitioners and undertakes not to do so in the future.

The learned Standing Counsel, on instructions, submits that any complaint received from the petitioners will be addressed promptly and in accordance with the law.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, in light of the above submissions, the petitioners do not wish to pursue the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition, along with all pending applications, stands disposed of.
