1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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3. The present petition has been filed with a limited prayer that directions be issued to the learned Debts Recovery Tribunal-II, New Delhi (hereinafter "DRT"), to dispose of the petitioner's pending objections filed vide **TRC/105/2022** titled ***TFCI v. Asiad Hotel & Ors*** in a time bound manner.
4. Despite advance service, except for respondent no.6, none of the respondents are represented.
5. In these circumstances, taking into account the limited prayer sought by the petitioner for expeditious disposal of his objections which, we



find are pending consideration before the learned DRT for the last almost eight years, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition by requesting the learned DRT to decide the petitioner's objections as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of three months. Further, we direct that no unnecessary adjournment will be granted to any of the parties.

6. A copy of this order be forwarded to the respondents.
7. The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
