1. The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution, complaining of alleged unauthorised construction in the property bearing *No. A-30/B, West Jyoti Nagar, Shahdara, Delhi*.

2. After some hearing, Mr. Chandra Kant Joshi, learned counsel for the petitioner, seeks permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to approach the Special Task Force ["STF"], constituted by the Supreme Court vide orders dated 24.04.2018 and 18.07.2018 in W.P.(C) 4677/1985 [*M.C. Mehta vs Union of India & Ors.*]. This submission is



made with reference to the decisions of the Division Bench in *Devender vs. Govt. of NCT of Delhi and Ors* [order dated 20.09.2018 in W.P.(C) 1807/2018], *Sneh Lata & Anr. vs. North Delhi Municipal Corporation & Anr.* [order dated 08.04.2019 in LPA 245/2019], *Fazruddin vs. DDA & Ors.* [order dated 23.04.2019 in WP (C) 4649/2017], and in *Himanshu vs. East Delhi Municipal Corporation & Anr.* [order dated 31.07.2023 in W.P.(C) 8104/2022], and decisions of coordinate Benches in *Abdul Gaffar vs South Delhi Municipal Corporation & Ors.* [order dated 28.02.2019 in W.P.(C) 1773/2019] and *Rashiduddin Malik vs. MCD & Ors.* [order dated 02.09.2024 in WP (C) 12102/2024].

3. Having regard to the above, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
