Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submitted that the dispute between the parties stands settled with the intervention of the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre vide settlement agreement dated 11th October, 2023 and the same is on record. Hence, nothing is left in the instant petition for further adjudication.

It is also submitted that the parties shall remain bound by the terms of the settlement.

On specific query of this Court, the respondent appearing in-person has categorically stated that the matter has been settled and he has received the entire amount as per the settlement.

This Court has perused the settlement agreement dated 11th October, 2023 and found nothing unlawful therein.



In view of the above facts and circumstances, the dispute in the instant petition does not survive anymore for further consideration. Accordingly, the parties are directed to remain bound by the terms of the said settlement agreement.

The instant petition alongwith pending application stands disposed of in terms of the settlement agreement dated 11th October, 2023.
