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Present petition has been filed seeking cancellation of the anticipatory bail granted to respondents no.2 and 3 by the Additional Sessions Judge vide order dated 02.06.2018 in case FIR no.385/2017 registered at PS G.T.B.Enclave under Section 420 IPC.
