1. The appeals in question were admitted and are to be listed in due course.
2. However, in between, there is a substantial development which has necessitated moving of the applications under disposal.
3. By virtue of these applications, the appellant now states that since the matter has been amicably settled, she may be permitted to

7. The Trial Court Record be sent back so that the learned Trial Court is in a position to complete the requisite remaining formalities in relation to grant of probate.
