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1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. against the impugned order and judgment dated 28.04.2018 passed by learned ASJ-05, South East District, Saket Courts, New Delhi in Criminal Revision No. 204195/2016 titled as Harikant Tripathi vs. State and Ors.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as respondent nos. 2 to 4 jointly submit that the parties have arrived at a settlement.
