% **ORDER**

1. Parties have executed Settlement Agreement dated 6th December, 2023, before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre. The said Agreement is signed by the Authorized Representatives of both parties and is accompanied with Board Resolutions in favour of the said Authorized Representatives.
