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1. The present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. seeks the following prayers:-

“a. Call for records and issue order, direction or writ in the nature of certiorari or any other similar writ for quashing and setting aside of impugned FIR No. RCDAl- 2016-A-0016 dated 12.05.2016 and consequent proceedings registered by Respondent No.1 and impugned Suspension Order No. F.4(10)/VIG/TPT/2015/1562-67 dated 26.12.2015 issued by Respondent No. 2 being arbitrary, illegal, unfair, unreasonable and violative of Articles 14, 16, 19 and 21 of the Court of India; AND  
b. Pass such other order or relief which this Hon'ble Court deem fit and appropriate in the facts and circumstances of the present case.”

2. Learned SPP for CBI, on instructions, submits that final report in the



present case FIR will be filed before the Court of competent jurisdiction within three weeks.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings in accordance with law, if need so arises.

4. Leave and liberty granted.

5. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
