1. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India
read with Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. seeks the following prayers:

- “a) Issue a writ /writs, direction/directions order or orders in the nature
of writ of certiorari or writ of appropriate nature thereby quashing the
FIR bearing number 192 of 2018 , registered at police station Shahdara,
Delhi on dated 5.7.2018 under section 325 read with section 34 of
Indian penal code qua the petitioner or thereby directing the respondent
to delete the name of the petitioner arrayed as accused in the said FIR
or in any proceeding arising out of the said FIR; and
b) Issue a writ /writs direction/directions, order or orders in the nature
of writ of mandamus thereby directing the respondent No. 1 to award
suitable compensation to the petitioner for prolonged harassment on the
basis of illegal FIR requesting into, illegal arrest, humiliation, insult in
the name of illegal investigation; and
c) Take action respondent no.2 and 3 for reporting false case in order to



humiliate and harass the petitioners.

d) Pass such further order/ orders this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice and equity.”

2. Petitioner, who appears in person through video conferencing, seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.
3. Leave granted.
4. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
5. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
