1. CM APPL. 20836/2024 has been moved on behalf of the respondent No.7/driver of the offending vehicle, seeking a direction to dispose of the instant appeal in terms of the compromise/settlement arrived at between the parties.
2. None appeared for the non-applicant/appellant/claimant when the matter was called.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant has pointed out that the parties mutually resolved their disputes before the learned MACT, Patiala House Court in terms of statement dated 26.11.2018 made amongst the parties.
