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1. The present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. seeks the following prayers:

Pass necessary orders and directions thereby quashing / setting aside all subsequent proceedings emanating from SC NO. 3-A/14 registered by the Respondent and dropping the charges framed thereafter. iii. 2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the latter, seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise the grounds taken herein during the course of trial before the learned Trial Court.
3. Leave and liberty granted.
4. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
