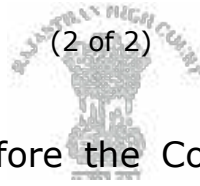

1. This civil misc. application has been filed seeking to restore the S.B. Arbitration Application No.124/2023, which was dismissed for non-prosecution by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 31.05.2024.
2. A perusal of order-sheets of Arbitration Application reveals that as many as five opportunities were granted to remove the defect(s), however, applicant failed to remove the same and



further did not appear before the Court, hence, the Arbitration Application was dismissed in default and for non-prosecution.

3. Counsel for applicant undertakes to remove the defect(s) pointed out by the Office within period of four weeks, soon after the restoration of the Arbitration Application and has assigned reasons for non-appearance.

4. Considering the reasons and the undertaking of counsel for applicant, the S.B. Civil Arbitration Application No.124/2023 is allowed to be restored to its original number, subject to deposition of cost of Rs.1000/- before the Litigants Welfare Fund by way of Banker's Cheque/ Demand Draft in the name of Registrar General, Rajasthan High Court within a period of four weeks. The receipt of deposition be filed in the office.

5. Accordingly, the misc. application stands disposed of.
