1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Shri S.B. Pandey, learned Senior Advocate and Deputy Solicitor General of India assisted by Shri Varun Pandey, learned counsel for the respondent Nos.1 to 4.

2. Petitioner has approached this Court claiming that appropriate orders are already passed by Supreme Court with regard to policy of the respondents.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the grievance of the petitioner would be sufficiently met in case his representation is considered and decided by the respondent No.2, Senior Divisional Commercial Manager, Northern-Eastern Railway, Ashok Marg, Lucknow in a time bound manner to which, learned counsel for respondents has no objection.

4. In view of aforesaid, the petitioner is permitted to move a fresh representation to the respondent No.2, Senior Divisional Commercial Manager, Northern-Eastern Railway, Ashok Marg, Lucknow within a period of two weeks from today, annexing therewith a certified copy of this order as well as all other documents in support of his claim. In case such a representation is moved, the respondent No.2 shall decide the same by a

reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law if possible within a period of six weeks from the date a certified copy of this order is placed before him.

5. With the aforesaid directions, present writ petition is disposed of.

6. It is made clear that this Court has not applied itself on the merits of the case and all questions are left open to be considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law.
