At the very outset, Sri Mahendra Kumar Mishra points out that the petitioner is a retired Central Government employee and consequently the claim of the petitioner would be cognizable before the learned Central Administrative Tribunal keeping in view the law laid down by a Constitution Bench judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the case of **L. Chandra Kumar vs. Union of India and others** reported in **AIR 1997 SC 1125**.

Consequently, the writ petition is disposed of leaving it open to the petitioner file a claim petition before the learned Central Administrative Tribunal for any of his grievance.
