1. Heard Sri P.K. Singh Bisen, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri S.B. Pandey, learned Senior Advocate and the Deputy Solicitor General of India assisted by Sri Dev Rishi Kumar, learned counsel for the opposite parties.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has requested that for redressal of his grievance the petitioner may be permitted to approach the opposite party No.3 by preferring a fresh representation and the direction may be issued to decide the said representation with expedition.

3. Therefore, without entering into merits of the issue, I hereby dispose of this writ petition finally at the admission stage giving liberty to the petitioner to approach the opposite party No.3 i.e. the Divisional Office P/ Recruitment, Personnel Branch, Mumbai, CSMT (Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus), Mumbai taking all pleas and grounds which are available with him annexing therewith copy of his earlier representation, if any, and the relevant documents in support of his claim within a period of ten days from today, and if any such representation is preferred by the petitioner within the aforesaid stipulated time, the authority concerned shall consider and decide the representation of the petitioner, strictly in accordance with law by passing a speaking and reasoned order, with expedition preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of presentation of a certified copy of this order along with representation and the decision thereof be intimated to the petitioner forthwith.

4. It is needless to say that if the petitioner feels himself aggrieved from the decision being taken on his representation, then he may approach the Central Administrative Tribunal by filing the Original Application (O.A.).

5. In view of the aforesaid terms, the instant writ petition is ***disposed of finally.***
