3 19-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Amas
P.S. Case No. 233 of 2024 registered for the offence punishable
under Sections 111, 109, 61(2) and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya
Sanhita, 2023 and Section 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 and 27 of the Arms
Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner is said to
have participated in the occurrence of getting the accused
person flee.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this
case. The petitioner is in custody since 06.08.2024 and claims
clean antecedent.



5. Learned APP appearing for the State opposes the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.S.J-3rd, Sherghati, Gaya/concerned Court in connection with Amas P.S. Case No. 233 of 2024.

7. At the time of accepting bail bonds of the petitioner, the Court below will verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner. If it is found that the petitioner has criminal antecedent, the Court below shall not accept the bail bonds of the petitioner and if it is found that the petitioner has clean antecedent, his bail bonds shall be accepted by the Court below.

8. The petitioner will also mark attendance in Amas Police Station, District- Gaya on every Sunday of the month. Any default in appearance at the Police Station would be result in cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner.
