2 03-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution story, the informant alleged that on 06.06.2024, he booked a truck through Omkar Transport and Railways for delivery of wheat worth Rs. 8,94,510/-. However, the truck never reached the destination. This led to the FIR.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. As a matter of fact, petitioner is agent of the transport company through with the wheat was booked and he has got no concern with the



truck in question. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned counsel for the informant vehemently opposed the bail application.

6. Considering the nature of accusation, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is refused.
