2 20-06-2025 At the outset, the learned counsel for the opposite parties has submitted that in compliance of the order of this Court dated 27.03.2019, passed in CWJC No.5952 of 2019, the District Programme Officer (Establishment), Supaul has passed an order dated 30.03.2020 whereby and whereunder upon recommendation of the District Compassionate Appointment Committee, Supaul, the petitioner has been appointed as a regular teacher in matric trained, in the pay-scale Rs.9300-



34800, grade pay Rs.4200/-.
