The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the issue involved in the present petition is with regard to absorption of non-formal instructor, which has stood concluded, however probably a petition is pending at the behest of the instructors before the Hon'ble Apex Court, thus, while disposing off the present petition, liberty be granted to the petitioners to re-agitate their grievances, in case any order is passed in favour of similarly situated instructors by the Hon'ble Apex Court.
