ORAL ORDER

2 24-02-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Sheikhpura P.S. Case No. 481 of 2024 dated 28.11.2024, registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) 56 (b) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 7.5 litres of illicit country-made liquor was recovered from the dickey of the Motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to criminal antecedents. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is the owner of the said motorcycle, but he has no



concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has seven criminal antecedents out of which six has similar nature of offence as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 29.11.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Sheikhpura in connection with Sheikhpura P.S. Case No. 481 of 2024, with the condition;-

(I). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
