2 12-02-2025 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Mejorganj P.S. Case No. 365 of 2024, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 310(4), 310(5), 317(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and Sections 25(1-b)a, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. Allegedly, the petitioner has been booked for recovery of a loaded country made pistol with live cartridges and eight piece of five hundred notes.

4. The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated. His name has been figured on confessional



statement of co-accused, Mukul Kumar Singh who was arrested at the spot. He also submits that the petitioner is a person of clean antecedent.

5. On the other hand, learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks before the learned court below, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Sitamarhi in connection with Mejorganj P.S. Case No. 365 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
