2. The present petition has been preferred for the
following relief(s):



“(i) To issue an appropriate Orders, directions is including /including a Writ Preferably in the nature of CERTIORARI for quashing the Order dated 29.4.2014 passed in B.L.T. Case No.153/13 filed by the Private Respondent No. 17 Under Sections 5 of the Bihar Land Tribunal Act 2005 and the same was allowed in his favour by Hon'ble Justice Mr. Mridula Mishra Setting aside the Order dated 6.05.14, passed by Joint Directer Consolidation Officer Gaya in Revision Case No. 4 of 2005.

(ii) To Direct the Consolidation Officer Gaya to Prepose the record of right in favour of the Petitioner and with respect to a land measuring 15 dec appertaining to Khata No.222(New), 01d (106), Plot No. 1075 (New), 323(01d) Chak Khata No.252(Ch) Chak Plot No.820 Situated in Village Mahuawari, P.S-Amas District Gaya. Which was Settled in favour of their father by exland.

(iii) To grant any other relief is to Which the Petitioner is entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.”
