the learned APP for the State.

2. Earlier anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 01.02.2023 in Cr. Misc. No. 68090 of 2021 but the petitioner is renewing his prayer for anticipatory bail on the fresh ground that the present case and its counter case lodged by the defense side have been compromised. The xerox copy of compromise petition, duly signed by both the parties and identified by their respective lawyers, is annexed with the record, which shows that cordial relation between the parties has restored.

3. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, in the event of his arrest or



surrender within four weeks before the learned court below, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate-Ist Class, Jamui in connection with Chandramandi P.S. Case No. 103 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
