on behalf of the petitioners and Mr. Satya Nand Shukla, learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection
with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 256 of 2024 registered for the
offence(s) punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 504,
506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the allegation made in the FIR, the accused
persons named therein including the petitioners had assaulted
the informant, as a result of which, he sustained injuries. Further



allegation is that they also snatched the chain and earring from the informant's wife.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that the injury is simple in nature and the same has been caused by hard and blunt substance. Petitioners have clean antecedents.

5. Learned APP for the State vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail.

6. Considering the nature of allegation made in the FIR, as well as, the fact that injury sustained by the victim is simple in nature and also the fact that petitioners have clean antecedents, I am of the opinion that petitioners have, prima facie, made out a case to be released on pre-arrest bail.

7. The petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 256 of 2024 , subject to



the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
