ORAL ORDER

2 20-02-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for
grant of regular bail in connection with Sangrampur P.S. Case
No. 147 of 2024 dated 10.06.2024 registered for the offences
punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 6 litres illicit
country made liquor was recovered from the motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. The petitioner is not the owner of the said vehicle and
he has no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has been



recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has eight criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 13.11.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Sangrampur P.S. Case No. 147 of 2024 with the condition :-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
