2. The petitioner, in the instant writ petition, prays for  
the following reliefs:-

*“i. For quashing of the order  
dated 16.04.2018 passed by the Bihar Land  
Tribunal, Patna in B.L.T. Case No. 173 of  
2018 whereby the application preferred  
under section 9 of the Bihar Land Tribunal  
Act, 2009 against the order dated 30.11.2017  
passed by the Divisional Commissioner was*



*dismissed and consequently the petitioner was directed to approach the Civil Court for redressal of his grievance;*

*ii. And/or for any other reliefs for which the petitioner may be found entitled in the facts and circumstances of the present case.”*

3. It has informed by the learned counsel for the petitioner that sole petitioner is no more and as such liberty be granted to the heirs if he/she/they want to approach afresh.

4. State has no objection.

5. Granting liberty to the heirs to move afresh if he/she/they so want, as the petitioner is no more, the writ petition stands disposed of.
