APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with  
Raniatalab P.S. Case No. 140 of 2024 registered for the offence  
punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307 and 504/34 of the  
Indian Penal Code.

3. The petitioner is said to have assaulted the victim  
with *khanti*.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this  
case. There is land dispute between the parties. The petitioner is  
in jail since 17.04.2024.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State opposes the



prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.D.J.-V, Danapur, Patna/ concerned Court in connection with Raniatalab P.S. Case No. 140 of 2024.
