2 15-02-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 120(b), 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per prosecution case, this petitioner got released two accused persons from police custody who were involved in liquor smuggling.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. As a matter of fact, on the instruction of SHO, Rail thana, Bhabua, this petitioner released the accused persons on PR bond and as such, petitioner has committed no offence. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.



5. Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposed the bail application.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Excise Judge No. 2, Gaya in connection with Rail (Bhabhua Road) P. S. Case No. 06 of 2024, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
