2 27-02-2025 Heard learned counsels for the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 274 and 275 of the B.N.S. and Sections 30(a) and 45 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 50 litres country made liquor has been recovered from bank of *Jhakiya* river.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case merely on suspicion. No incriminating article has been recovered from conscious possession of this petitioner. The alleged illicit liquor has been recovered from an open place.

5. On the other hand, learned A.P.P. for the State has



vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and submitted that petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and has also got three criminal antecedents of similar nature.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, huge quantity of recovery and the fact that petitioner has got three criminal antecedents of similar nature, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is rejected.
