3 27-06-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Pauthu P.S. Case No. 44 of 2024 instituted for the offences
under Sections 302, 201, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that the accused
persons including the petitioner have killed the deceased.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case.
Petitioner is the mother-in-law of the deceased. Learned
counsel for the petitioner submitted that general and omnibus
allegation has been made against the petitioner. No specific
overt act is alleged against the petitioner. Learned counsel
further submitted that petitioner is separate in mess and business
and has got no concern in the family affairs of the deceased and



her husband. Husband of the deceased is already in custody. Learned counsel further submitted that as per paragraph nos. 27 and 28 of the case diary, the specific allegation of assaulting the deceased is against the husband of the deceased. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as also there being no specific allegation against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Pauthu P.S. Case No. 44 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
