2. The present writ petition has been filed for the
following reliefs :-

*i. For issuance of direction/directions or
order/orders or writ/writs in the nature of*



Mandamus for commanding and directing the Respondent authority to demarcate the Land in the light of order dated 27.03.1993 passed in Demarcation Case No. 17 of 1992-93 by the Deputy Collector cum Land Reforms, Danapur (Respondent No.4) affirmed in Demarcation Appeal No. 12/1993-94 vide order dated 04.01.2008 by the Collector cum District Magistrate, Patna (Respondent No.2) and the same has been upheld by the Hon'ble High Court Patna vide its order dated 19.07.2013 passed in C.W.J.C.No. 1710 of 2009 as well as appellate order dated 19.09.2016 passed in L.P.A.No. 1113 of 2014 and attained finality.

ii. For any other relief/ reliefs to which the petitioner is found legally entitled.
