2.The present petition has been preferred for the

7.6.2017 passed by the respondent-
Executive Engineer as contained in
Annexure-3 as well as the
rehabilitation 'Purcha' dated
15.6.2017 issued in favour of*



*respondents 2nd Party as contained in
Annexure-4, be issued;*

*(ii) an appropriate writ, order or
direction commanding the respondents
2nd Party to forbear from effecting
delivery of possession of the land in
question to the respondents 2nd Party,
be issued*

*(iii) an appropriate writ, order or
direction commanding the respondents
2nd Party restraining them from
interfering in any way with the
petitioner's possession over the land
mentioned in Annexures 3 and. 4, be
issued.*
