The writ petition has been filed for:-

*“(a) For quashing of the order dated
26.5.2017 passed by the Bihar Land Tribunal in
BLT Case No.156/2016; order dated
16.12.2014 passed by the Additional Member,
Board of Revenue, Bihar of Revenue, Bihar,
Patna Land Ceiling Revision Case No.56/1999
and also the order dated 29.1.1999 passed by*



the Additional Collector, Saran in Land Ceiling Appeal No.31/97 by which pre-emption application has been allowed.

(b) For upholding the order dated 9.9.1997 passed in land Ceiling Case No.16/95-96 by the DCLR, Sadar Chapra who dismissed the pre-emption application.

(c) For grant of stay of the operation of the impugned orders dated 26.5.2017.
