2. The present application has been preferred for the

no one is in physical possession over the
land in question in accordance with
consolidation rather the present petitioner*



and other villagers also is in physical possession as per survey and itself may be declared final for the interest of the petitioner.

3. It is the stand of the State that the petitioner claims to have purchased the land in the year 2013 but, however, in the year 1981 (31.03.1981) itself, the *Chak* land was confirmed. The submission is that even the said declaration has not been attached with the petition.

4. Be that as it may, since there is no appearance, dismissed for non-prosecution.
