A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Bhorey P.S. Case No. 333 of 2024 dated 05.12.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 8(c) and 21(b) of the NDPS Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 2.34 grams of smack like substance was recovered from the possession of the petitioner and 1.76 grams of smack like substance was recovered from the possession of the co-accused Mantu Ram.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the seized contraband is



small quantity. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 07.12.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Gopalganj in connection with Bhorey P.S. Case No. 333 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
