Regarding Cr. Misc. No. 6123 of 2025

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State .

2. Petitioner seeks regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 137 (2) and 140 (3) of BNS.

3 . As per the prosecution case , informant alleged that on 14.10.2024, son of informant went to visit durga mata temple but did not return . Thereafter, informant and his relative began to search but he was not found. F.I.R., has been lodged against unknown .

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R., The name of the petitioner transpired during course of investigation on the confessional statement of injured Ayush Kumar. Except confessional statement there is no other material on record to show the complicity of this petitioner in this case . As a matter of fact, there was love affairs between deceased Ayush Kumar and one Amrita Kumari and petitioner has got no concern with the alleged occurrence . Petitioner claims clean antecedent. Petitioner is in custody since 18.10.2024 .



5 . Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that it is a case of honour killing in which all the accused persons including this petitioner committed murder of son of informant on the suspicion that son of informant had love affair with one Amrita Kumari. Post mortem report reveals that multiple injuries were found on the body of deceased Ayush Kumar.

6. Considering the nature of accusation , material available on record and gravity of offence , I am not inclined to interfere with the order impugned and as such , prayer for regular bail of the petitioner is rejected.

Petitioner is in custody since 13.11.2024 .

Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that it is a case of honour killing in which all the accused persons including this petitioner committed murder of son of informant on the suspicion that son of informant had love affair with one Amrita Kumari. Post mortem report reveals that multiple injuries were found on the body of deceased Ayush Kumar.
