2 04-03-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State .

2. Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 147, 341 , 323 , 324, 307, 354-B, 379, 504 506 r/ w Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code .

3 . As per F.I.R., on the alleged date and time of occurrence , all the accused persons with common intention were digging inside the purchased land of informant to construct a wall, and when informant opposed the same , then all the accused persons assaulted informant with lathi and handa . When the family members of the informant came to save , they



were also assaulted by accused persons.

4. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that dispute over land led to free fight between the parties. Both sides sustained injuries. Case and counter case . Injuries are simple in nature . Petitioners claim clean antecedent.

5 . Learned counsel for the State oppose the bail petition .

6 Considering the nature of injury , clean antecedent of these petitioners and other circumstances of the case , in the event of arrest or surrender within eight weeks from today, let the petitioners, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate - 1st Class, Saran at Chapra in connection with Janta Bazar P.S. Case No. 112 of 2022 , subject to the conditions laid down under section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure .
