2 21-08-2025 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has filed present application for quashing the first information report of Khajauli P.S. Case No. 117 of 2017 dated 14.10.2017 which has been registered against the petitioner on the written statement of proprietor of Kasturba Gandhi Balik Vidyalay Khajauli Madhubani.
