2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State

informs that in light of the order dated 21.08.2023 passed in



CWJC No. 3357 of 2023, the representation filed by the petitioner in respect of the payment of remaining amount of retiral dues after granting benefit of A.C.P. within a period of six weeks, has been disposed of vide Memo No. 344 dated 03.03.2025 and the payment has already been made within the said period.
