2. This is second anticipatory bail petition. Earlier, the petition, filed for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of petitioners, stood rejected, *vide* order dated 04.10.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 61153 of 2024.

3. This application does not reveal any change of circumstances or new ground.



4. In view of the recent judgment of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in the case of *G.R. Ananda Babu Vs. State of Tamil Nadu and Anrs* reported in **2021 SCC OnLine SC 176**, the second anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioners is not maintainable. It is, accordingly, dismissed.
