2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Majorganj P.S. Case No. 399 of 2024 dated 24.11.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 317(5) of BNS and Sections 30(a), 30(c), 32 and 36 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act and Section 25(1-B)(a), 26 and 35 of Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 54 litres of illicit Nepali country-made liquor, one country-made pistol and two live cartridges were recovered from the sack tied with the motorcycle of the co-accused, Rupam Kumar.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this



case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has two criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 25.11.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Sitamarhi in connection with Majorganj P.S. Case No. 399 of 2024, with the condition:-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bonds of the petitioner are liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
