1. The petitioner has filed the Writ
petition for the following reliefs:

*“ for quashing the
certificate proceeding bearing
Certificate Case No.01 of 2017-18,
pending in the court of Certificate
Officer, Begusarai as well as the notice
dated 5.9.2017 issued in the said
Certificate case to the petitioner and
further for any other relief or reliefs for*



which the petitioner is entitled in the facts and circumstances of the present writ application."

2. At the outset, the Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks indulgence of this Court to grant liberty to file fresh objections under Section 9 of the Bihar and Orissa Public Demands Recovery Act, 1914 and direct the authority to pass necessary orders duly taking into account the objections filed by the petitioner.

3. The Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that he has no objection, if a direction is given to the concerned authority to pass necessary orders under Section 10 of the Act duly taking into account the objections filed by the petitioner.

4. Having regard to the above made submissions, without going into the merits or demerits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to file fresh objections under Section 9 before the concerned authority within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the order. On such



objections being filed, the authority concerned shall pass necessary orders under Section 10 of the Act.

5. It is needless to mention that before passing any order, the authority concerned shall give an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. Any order passed shall be communicated to the petitioner. The entire exercise shall be completed as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date of filing of the objections by the petitioner.

6. Till the passing of the final order by the Certificate Officer, it is directed that no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner herein.

7. Interlocutory Application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
